

Vocabulary Homework Choice Menu

Directions: Every set of vocabulary words you will choose 4 different activities from the choices below to help you practice and learn the words. All vocabulary words must be spelled correctly to receive full credit. You will choose 2 activities each week to complete and you have the words for 2 weeks, so a total of 4 assignments will be completed for each set of words.

<p align="center">Comic Book Panels</p> <p>Make 6 drawings with captions and speech bubbles, using at least 8 of your words correctly. Put details in your drawing so it is clear how your pictures relate to the words. Comic book panels should tell a story.</p>	<p align="center">Illustrated Dictionary</p> <p>Create pictures for all 14 of your words. Each word should have an illustration that helps explain what the word means.</p>
<p align="center">Conversation</p> <p>Write a conversation between two or more people using your 14 words. Make sure your dialogue is in complete sentences with the correct punctuation. <i>Each time a new person speaks it should go on a new line.</i></p> <p>Example Mom: "Put your coat on." Joe: "I don't think it is that <u>frigid</u> outside today."</p>	<p align="center">Creative Characters</p> <p>Create specific descriptions of 7 different characters whose last names are your vocabulary words. Each person should have their personality, job, and appearance listed—they should also be related to the meaning of the word.</p> <p>Example: Mr. <u>Stingy</u> Personality: He does not like to spend money Job: Banker Appearance: All of his pockets have zippers to keep his money safe.</p>
<p align="center">Sentences</p> <p>Write each word in a sentence for all 14 words. Each sentence must make sense and use the word correctly.</p>	<p align="center">Ad</p> <p>Write an ad for your favorite food, car, toy or place (or invention) using 6 of your words. The ad should have a headline, 1 picture, and 5-8 sentences explaining the product or place. Be creative and have fun!</p>
<p align="center">Short Story</p> <p>Write a short story (3-5 paragraphs) using 8 of your words. Have fun and be creative with it! Make sure your story has:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Characters 2. Problem and solution 3. Setting 	<p align="center">Definitions</p> <p>Write the word and the definition for all 14 of your words. Make sure you write clearly so that they can be read.</p>
